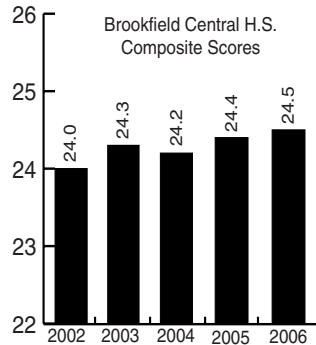

Facilities and Student Achievement

While the ACT scores are strong, (maximum score is 36), student achievement in science may be most impacted by facilities needs, and the ACT scores reflect it. For example, there are too few labs for the number of lab science classes taught and the number of students enrolled. As a result, some science classes are taught in regular classrooms without lab facilities and other science classes are taught by teachers who don't have their own classrooms and therefore don't have time to set up the labs as they travel throughout the day from room to room.

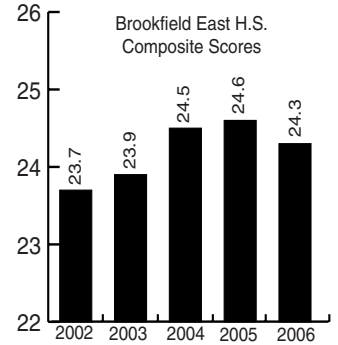
ACT Composite Scores for Brookfield Central H.S.

Number of Brookfield Central H.S. students tested in 2006: 258

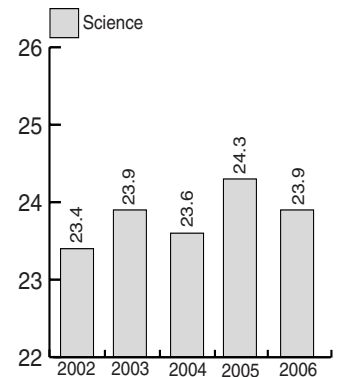
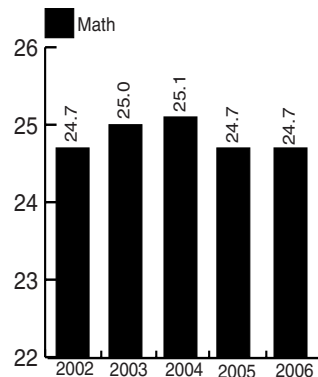
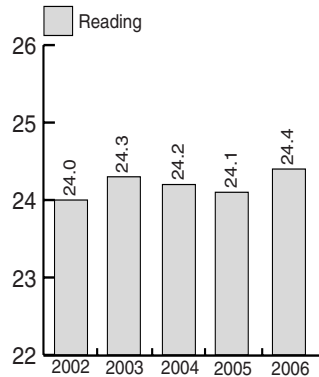
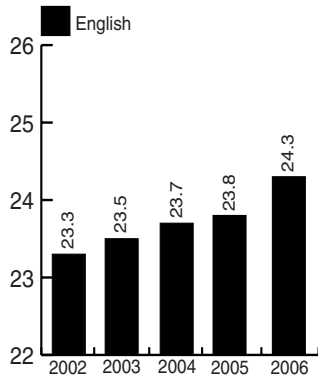


ACT Composite Scores for Brookfield East H.S.

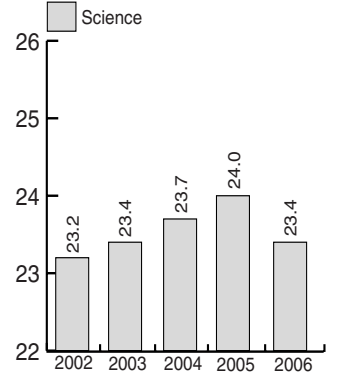
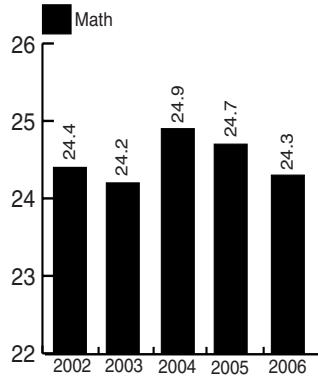
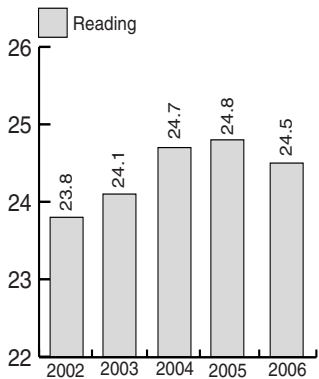
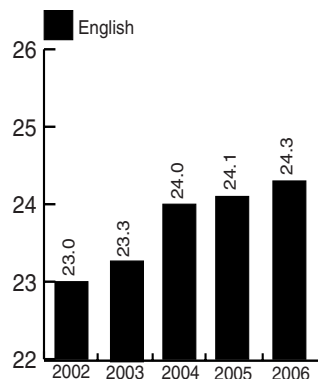
Number of Brookfield East H.S. students tested in 2006: 277
