Academic Achievement

The Wisconsin State Assessment System (WSAS) is a state-mandated, five subject test taken in grades 3-8, and 10. Aligned to rigorous national standards, students' math and reading scores are categorized as minimal, basic, proficient or advanced. Elmbrook students outperform county and state benchmark averages in all subject areas.
