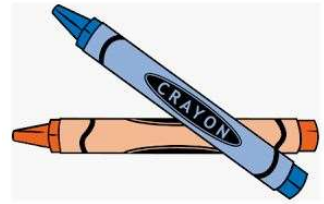


# SWANSON ELEMENTARY 2019-2020 SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST



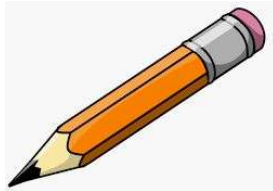

## **All students will also need:**

- Art Shirt-All children will need a long-sleeved shirt to cover clothing in art class. This can be any type of smock, even one of dad's old shirts.
- Gym Shoes-All Students need tennis shoes or other type of gym shoes for PE class.
- Book Bag/Backpack (*no wheels*)

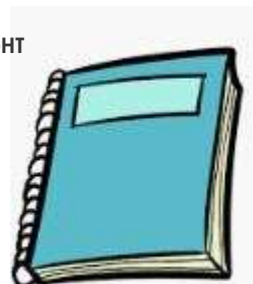

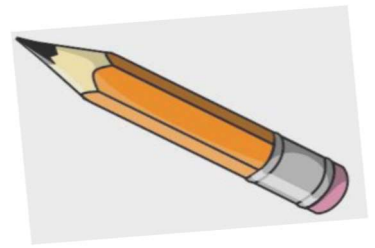
