

This document is intended to give parents some general information to help prepare for the fall athletic season. Online Registration:

Registration for all sports is done online at www.brookfieldeasthighschool-ar.rschooltoday.com. Once information is initially entered it will be saved in your account for future registrations. An athletics registration informational sheet is included in your registration materials to help you through the process.

Physical Card (Medical Clearance):

Prior to participating in any tryout, practice, or event, your student must have a current physical signed by a doctor and guardian on file. The date on this physical must be on or **after 4/1/17**. You can call the athletic office (262-781-1045) if you need to check on the status of medical clearance for your son or daughter. The required form can be downloaded, picked up in the main office or the athletic office at Brookfield East. Completed forms should be uploaded to the athletic registration site (Step 4). If your son/daughter does not need a physical for 2018-19 (he/she had one on or after 4/1/17) only the physical date (if known) needs to be added in Step 4 of the online registration process.

Eligibility:

All athletes must meet the eligibility requirements established by the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association in order to compete for Brookfield East. Additionally, athletes and parents are required to electronically sign (Step 6 of the online registration process) a form indicating their understanding and compliance with the rules of eligibility established by the WIAA.

Co-Curricular Code of Conduct:

It is a privilege to represent the Spartans in competition. Please review the code with your student-athletes and be sure all the expectations and consequences are clearly understood. The Activity Code of Conduct is electronically signed (Step 6 of the online registration process) by both student-athletes and parents. If needed, the Co-Curricular Code of Conduct can be downloaded or picked up in the main office or the athletic office at Brookfield East.

Concussion Form:

Before a student may participate in practice or competition, a concussion information acknowledgment form must be electronically signed by both parent and student-athlete (Step 6 of the online registration process). If needed, forms can be downloaded or picked up in the main office or the athletic office at Brookfield East.

Activity Fee:

All athletes must pay the **district required \$80** activity fee each year before participating in competition for Brookfield East. A total of \$160 annually is to be paid for multi-sport athletes. Athletes participating in a third program do not pay those additional fees. Fees can be paid at BEHS or through My Payments Plus (www.mypaymentsplus.com).
