The Elmbrook Cup

The Elmbrook Cup is a travelling trophy that is awarded to the top performing Elmbrook elementary school at the annual Spartan Chess Open. This year's Spartan Chess Open is February 12th, 2022.

Elmbrook Cup Scoring System

For each of the Elmbrook elementary schools, the top five player Elmbrook Scores total is the team score. There is no limit to the number of players per school. Players choose to compete in the K-5 Non-Rated or K-8 Rated section, both are five rounds. Here is how to calculate an individual player's Elmbrook Score:

Non-Rated K-5: normal score = Elmbrook Score
USCF Rated K-8 normal score x 1.5 = Elmbrook Score

For example, a school's team score for the Elmbrook Cup could be calculated like this:

Player 1: 5 wins in the K-5 Non-Rated $= 5 \times 1$ = 5 points Player 2: 4 wins in the K-5 Non-Rated = 4 x 1 = 4 points Player 3: 3.5 wins in the K-5 Non-Rated = 3.5×1 = 3.5 points Player 4: = 3 x 1.5 = 4.5 points 3 wins in the K-8 Rated Player 5: 4 wins in the K-8 Rated $= 4 \times 1.5$ = 6 points TEAM TOTAL = 23 points
