


## Pilgrim Park Middle School Facility Profile

Opened as junior high school (grades 7-9) in 1958. In 1984 the name changed to Elmbrook Middle School serving grades 7-8. Grade configuration changed in 1997 and renamed back to Pilgrim Park Middle when Wisconsin Hills opened as 2nd middle school.
