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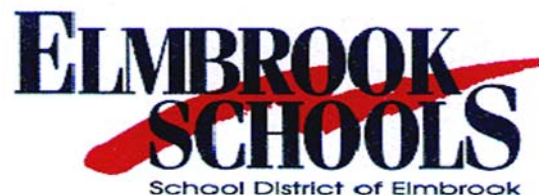

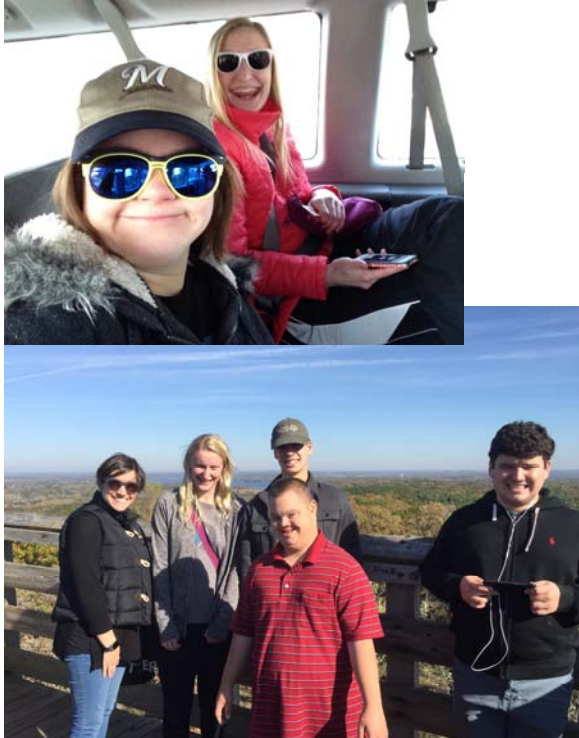

Project STRIVE

Adult transition service for 19-21 year old young adults with intellectual disabilities and/or autism that focuses solely on transition goals and priorities to further develop independent living skills, social communication, vocational abilities, and recreational skills. Project STRIVE works with various outside agencies, such as the Department of Health Services, Division of Vocational Rehabilitation, Waukesha County Technical College (WCTC), and community businesses. Project STRIVE coordinates training from an apartment within the community.



Student Eligibility Requirements

- Independent Self-Care Skills: Ability to take care of personal hygiene with minimal assistance
- Community Safety: Ability to follow directions and exhibit safe behavior.
- Socialization: Ability to interact with adults and peers in all environments: the apartment, community and a vocational setting
- Completed high school graduation on requirements and must be 19 to enter Project STRIVE (start dates September 1 or first day of second semester)



Student Eligibility Requirements

- Vocational skills: Eligible for services through the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR) or open to volunteering in the community
- Independent Living Skills: Ability to participate with moderate adult supervision and assistance
- Family Participation: Families/Guardians expected to participate in meeting upon request, possible fundraising efforts and reciprocate communication as requested
- Families and students will tour and STRIVE instructors or District Transition Coordinator will be involved in IEP meeting discussions to determine eligibility
