Tanya clarified the Proposed Outcome Key.

5th Grade

Some standards are repeated per statute. They were are defined in a band so some are repeated to show emphasis.

Jack mentioned ‘body image’ is too narrow in regards to the influence of social media, to add self-esteem. Requested that wording be broadened. Point 7 will be expanded.

Reminder from last meeting, that ‘trusted adult’ will be expanded to emphasize parents and family.

It was mentioned if someone who is viewed as trusted , violates the trust, what is mentioned on how to handle that. It is mentioned in 2nd grade band.

Victim perspective is majority, what happens if I am am the violator? How do I admit it or apologize? This is a situation for teachers, counselors. Message before this happens, that we know there will be mistakes (hurt feelings). It can be mentioned in the bullet points about positive relationships. Mentioned in points that can define why people tease, harass etc. Create awareness to not stay silent when we see abuse.

We encourage kids to go to a trusted adult in earlier grades. At what age do we encourage kids to search out their own answers? And what types of places do we encourage them to look? More than online, kids have access to other good information. When and what resources do we want to endorse? Connection to digital citizenship. Standard 2.

Remove last point and add standards to the one above.

How do we address the stress factor of increased “digital life”. Is the place of this in digital citizenship or health classes? Technology is mentioned in many content areas. It was mentioned by the committee that HG&D might be a good place to ensure that the health effects are covered. Add bullet to 3-5 band that progresses. There are bullets in 6-8 band that could be brought back to the 3-5 strand and have it built out and expanded. Request to add “and self” to 6th grade bullets on back page.

6th Grade

Reminder that language will be pulled throughout all grades from the last meeting.

Request to combine points 2 and 8.

	<p>In 6th grade, start using term sexual intercourse. Need to talk about more than just reproduction, add all points - which are mentioned in 7th grade. Points 3, 4, and 5 are a package and will be moved to 7th grade. Keep 6th grade as a basic, medical description (point 1).</p> <p>How much time is spent on HG&D? Minimal currently, the amount of time spent will be evaluated by this committee.</p> <p>Wording in last bullet is intentional. Request to add word “integrity” to final point.</p> <p>Request to add importance of sleep...will check if it is covered in FCS.</p> <p>7th Grade Educators will create lesson plans and then the committee will review them and review materials.</p> <p>Current bullet about sexual stereotyping and discrimination requested to be added to the proposed column (7th grade).</p> <p>Do we address if a student expresses issues with gender/sexual identity? It is in national standards in 6-8. Frame conversation to discuss and respect. The committee will think about sexual orientation and gender identity, what and when should be included for discussion at next meeting. Curriculum designed so that parents can opt kids out of parts of it, as parents choose. Make learning targets very clear for parents to make a choice.</p> <p>Also, think about how sex is taught as far as stating it should only be inside of marriage. Religious perspective, think about how decision to have sex fits inside of the belief system.</p> <p>The plan is to send K-5 proposed outcomes to the Teaching and Learning Committee as a discussion item on January 8th, 2018 for feedback.</p> <p>Next meeting TBD. It will be in January after 8th. The consensus was to have on longer meeting in January instead of 2.</p>
