# **Comprehensive Evaluation of Gifted and Talented Program for School District of Elmbrook**

Teaching and Learning Department

## Purpose:

Wisconsin Statute 121.02(1)(t) mandates each school board to provide access to an appropriate program for pupils identified as gifted and talented. In The School District of Elmbrook (SDE), we are committed to inspiring and educating all students. In the School District of Elmbrook 8.7% of our students are identified as gifted.

Several concerns of stakeholders in the SDE have prompted a comprehensive program evaluation of gifted and talented services. These include:

- Past focus was on identification criteria but not comprehensive systemic programming for our gifted learners
- Established criteria in reading, mathematics and general intellect were developed in 2008; however criteria for Leadership, Creativity, Fine Arts, Writing, Science and Social Students have not been universally implemented as directed in Policy & Practice Statement 6142.1
- Response to Intervention (RTI) work in SDE has focused on our most struggling learners, however best
  practice cites that a robust RTI system meets the needs of all learners. Therefore a mutli-level system
  of supports is essential for students who are gifted and talented. For more information about Gifted and

- Programming for gifted education varies across the SDE. Lacking is systematic and continuous gifted programming model that meets the individual needs of advanced learners.

Therefore, to move forward with systematic and rigorous GT programming, a comprehensive program evaluation will be done. This internal program review will be conducted by Dr. Scott Peters. He will collaborate with staff, students, and families to:

- 1. Evaluate the state of gifted education policy and programming with regard to WI State rules and statutes
- 2. Evaluate the state of gifted education policy and practice with regard to best practices
- 3. Evaluate the degree to which existing programming is meeting the needs of students
- 4. Provide feedback and suggestions for improvement to programming

### **Process:**

Dr. Scott Peters will conduct a comprehensive program review that will use both quantitative and qualitative data. This information will be gathered through a systematic review of existing data and records in conjunction with focus groups for administration, staff, and families and site visits. Upon completion of this work Dr. Peters will provide the SDE with a written report related to the four items above.

Upon receipt and review of the comprehensive program review, the Gifted and Talented steering committee that will lead leveled work groups. Work groups will create an identification process that meets Administrative Rule 8.01(2)(t)2 by including a student profile based on multiple measures, including but not limited to standardized test data, nominations, rating scales or inventories, products, portfolios, and demonstrated performance. In addition, researched based identification tools identified will be appropriate for the specific purpose for which they are being employed. Moreover, recommendations for an appropriate, systematic and continuous K-12 program that includes learning activities that will allow all of our gifted students to grow academically, socially, and emotionally will be created.

### **Outcomes:**

- 1. Create a comprehensive and systematic gifted screening and identification process.
- 2. Create a systematic and continuous gifted programming model with varied opportunities for advanced learners to fit their individual need(s).
- 3. Create template for annual evaluation of effectiveness of G/T program effectiveness
